"At the Sikh temple they give out free food to all the visitors. It was really tasty," Jaxon (Year 3 Iroko class).

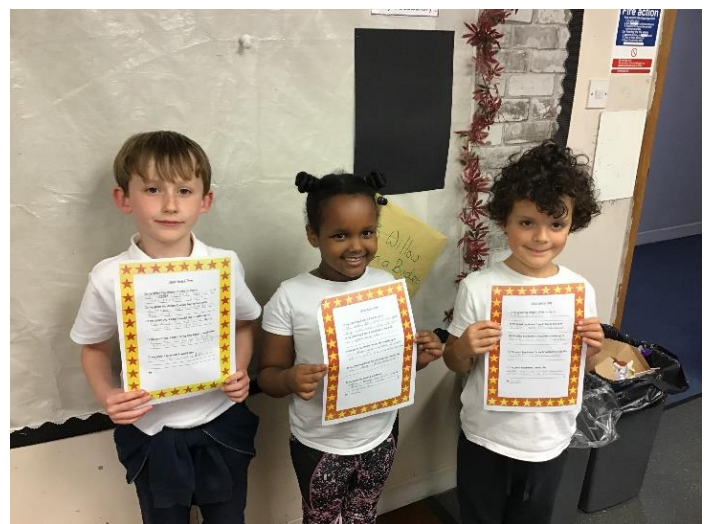
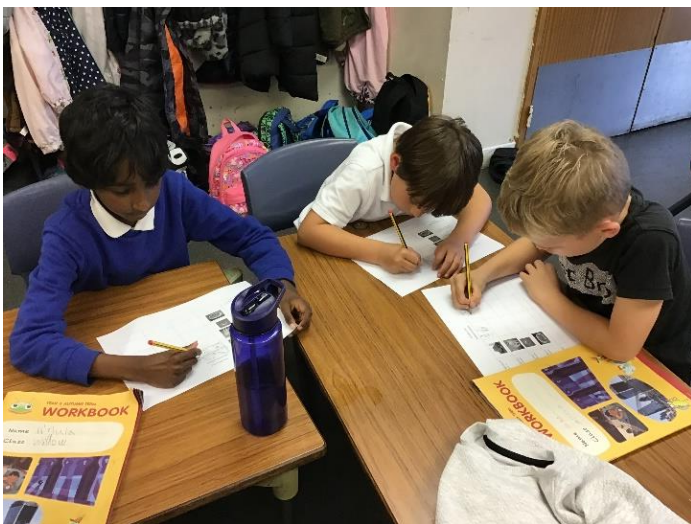
## Year 5 Beech Class Anglo-Saxon assembly


