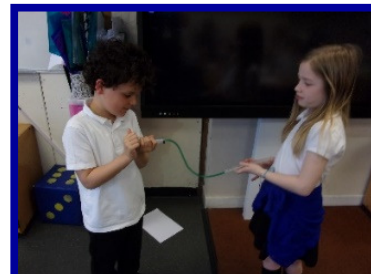
In class this week
