'Travel Back in Time' Day

To celebrate the learning that has taken place this half term in History lessons, we have planned a 'Travel Back in Time' Day on Tuesday 11th October 2022.

The Junior school hall will be transformed into 'Harefield History Museum' where children from years 1 to 6 will be sharing what they have been learning about. Throughout the day, each of the year 1 to 6 classes will visit the 'museum' to find out about the different history topics everyone has been studying.

We would also like to invite parents in to the 'museum' in the Junior school hall at 9am on Tuesday 11th October 2022 to see some of the fantastic learning that has taken place across both schools.

As well as the 'Harefield History Museum' in the Junior school hall, it will be a non-uniform day, where we would like children to come in to school dressed up in costumes linked to their current History topic. The children will be making props to accompany their costumes in class, linked to their learning (please speak to your child's class teacher for more details). Some key information is included below:

Year 1: My family History

The children will begin to explore the similarities and differences of homes, toys and schools between their own lives and those of people their grandparents' age. Children can come in to school dressed as granny or grandad.



Year 2: Bonfire Night and the Great Fire of London

The children will learn about the Gunpowder plot, which led to the events of November the 5th. Children can come in to school dressed up in clothes from 1600s or as Guy Fawkes himself.

Year 3: Local History

Children will be exploring the history of Harefield including its heritage of farming. Children can come in to school dressed up as farmers.



Year 4: Ancient Egyptians

Children can dress up as Egyptian Pharaohs/Queens or mummies.



Year 5: The Vikings

Children can dress up as Viking warriors.

Year 6: The Impact of War

Children could dress up as evacuees during wartime or soldiers.



We look forward to welcoming you to Harefield's 'Travel Back in Time' Day and hope you will enjoy learning about the different topics as much as the children have.
