We have a few events planned over the next few months...

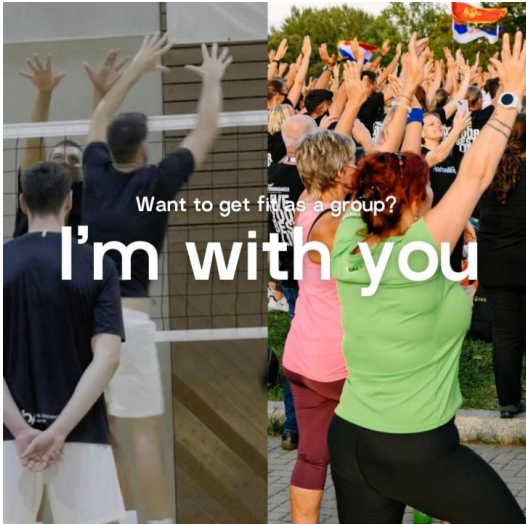
